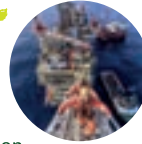


Airports fuelled by Air bp

North Sea oil and gas

Today: Meeting today's energy needs through reliable and responsible oil and gas production, while reducing operational emissions.

Tomorrow: Fuelling the energy transition, eliminating routine flaring and exploring options to electrify assets using clean power.



Supply chain

Today: Spending billions with UK suppliers and in 2019, 23% of that was in the Scottish supply chain.

Tomorrow: Ensuring our home-grown oil and gas supply chain can transition with us on the path to net zero.

Air bp

Today: Leading supplier and marketer of aviation fuel at all main airports in Scotland, including Aberdeen where we are the main supplier to offshore helicopters.

Tomorrow: Leader in setting up new supply chains for sustainable aviation fuel and actively working with airports and customers in Scotland to transition to sustainable aviation fuel.

Skills and a just transition

Today: In 2019 we provided 2,157 direct and 13,200 indirect high-skilled jobs in Scotland while nurturing the next generation through STEM initiatives in schools, colleges and universities.

Tomorrow: Leveraging our people's skills to advance the energy transition, while inspiring and building the renewable energy skills in the next generation to help the world get to net zero.

Universities

Today: Investing in four universities across Scotland to develop the skills and knowledge needed for a successful oil and gas industry.

Tomorrow: Partnering with universities to establish Scotland as a centre of excellence for low carbon energy, developing the knowledge and skills we need for the energy transition.

Scottish retail sites

Today: Servicing 400k+ customers each week from our 116 prime retail sites with everyday convenience and quality fuels, including bp Ultimate which helps your engine run efficiently.

Tomorrow: Roll out of rapid and ultra-fast charging points on forecourts and introduction of lower carbon E10 fuel at the pump.



Community and Workforce benefit

Today: Investing £1m in the redevelopment of Aberdeen Art Gallery, supporting cultural institutions like Scottish Ballet and the Commonwealth Games in 2014 and signing up to the Scottish Business Pledge.

Tomorrow: continuing to invest in community and sustainability projects.

Shetland

Today: Supporting Shetland's economy through the export of oil from the giant Clair field through Sullom Voe Terminal.

Tomorrow: Securing a long-term export route for Clair to maximize value from the field and funding feasibility studies for the integrated Shetland Energy hub.



Offshore Wind

Today: Bidding for a lease in the first ScotWind leasing round and launched a bespoke supplier portal to help Scottish companies.

Tomorrow: Building and operating our first Scottish North Sea wind farm, fully operational by 2030.

Growing Scottish forestry

Today: 8.3 million trees planted through our £10million investment in Scottish Forestry Alliance over the last two decades.

Tomorrow: Enabling the planting of a further one million trees as a founding partner of Future Woodlands Scotland.

Aberdeen city partnership

Today: We chose Aberdeen as one of our first global cities to partner with to help deliver Aberdeen's vision to become a climate positive city centred around opportunities in hydrogen, built environment, mobility and the circular economy.

Tomorrow: Deepening and delivering the partnership to bring an integrated energy system vision to fruition in the city.

North Sea HQ, Dyce, Aberdeen

Today: Home to 900 strong headcount based out of our Aberdeen office supporting safe and reliable oil and gas operations.

Tomorrow: Home to a multi-discipline integrated team supporting low-carbon energy operations as well as oil and gas.

Lightsourcebp

Today: Producing 4MW of clean energy at our Presscock Solar Farm in Angus via more than 15,000 solar panels.

Tomorrow: Deploying new technologies to improve performance and continually looking for future opportunities.

bp pulse

Today: Supplying Police Scotland with over 1,000 electric vehicle (EV) chargepoints across 265 of their locations and opening one of the first ultra-fast charging motorway sites in the UK, along the M8 Glasgow to Edinburgh.

Tomorrow: expanding our ultra-fast charging network across our retail sites in Scotland for passenger cars.
