Customers can also use the BPMe app, which allows customers to pay for their fuel from inside their car, as well as having pre-order their coffee before even arriving at the site – all designed to make the bp experience faster and easier.

bp is committed to delivering more sustainable operations and are continually looking at new ways to improve energy efficiency at store-level. This includes using energy LED lighting in the shop and forecourt, utilising recycled heat from refrigeration systems for water heating and collecting re-useable rainwater from the rooftop.

bp Connect Bethlehem becomes the 108th bp Connect site nationwide and the 9th bp Connect site in the Bay of Plenty region. There are a further 104 bp dealer sites located around New Zealand.
